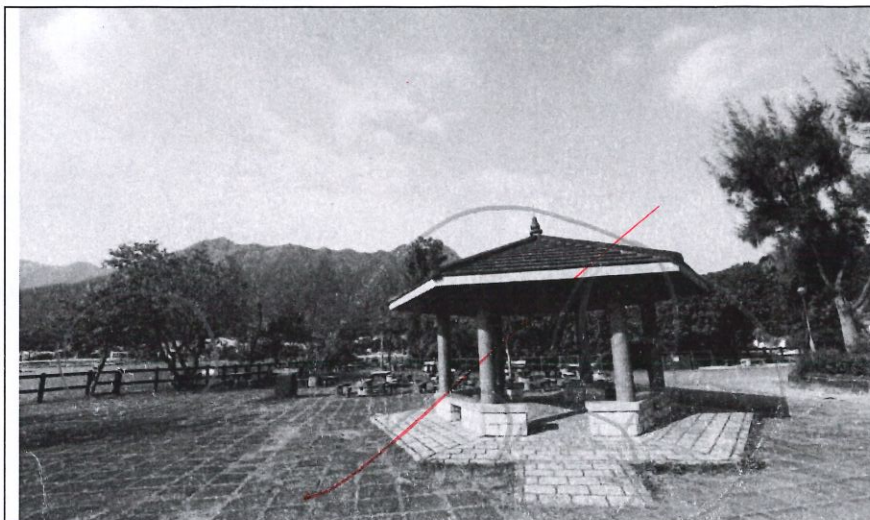
A. Learning Objectives:

It is hard / soft, transparent / non-transparent and elastic / non-elastic.

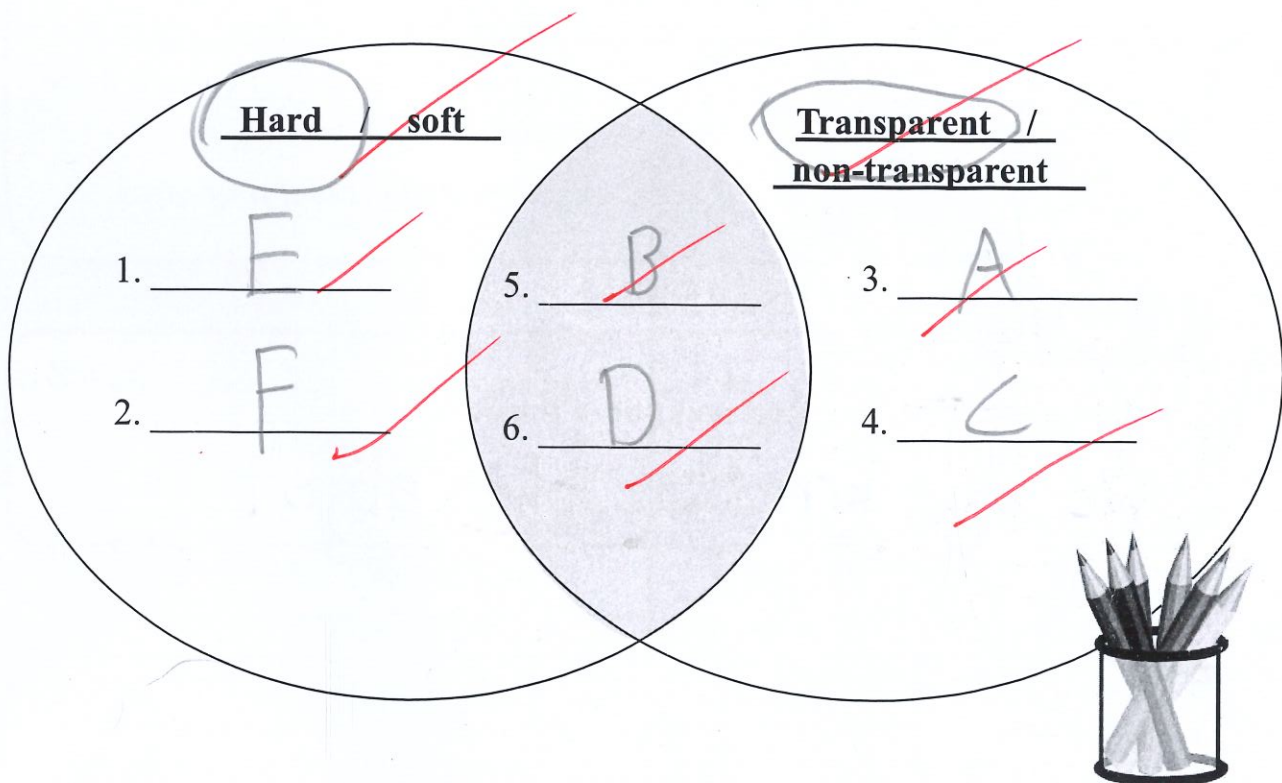
