	Traditional maps	Electronic maps
Places	They use <u>symbols</u> ✓ to show different places, e.g. 'P' stands for car park.	
Scale	Fixed	The <u>ratio</u> ✓ of the map can be changed by zooming in and out.
How to locate places	Read the key and locate places using the <u>grid references</u> ✓.	There are three ways: 1. Enter the location by typing 2. Use <u>GPS</u> ✓ 3. Tap the place on the <u>map</u> ✓
How to plan routes	Route planning function is unavailable.	Route planning function is available. The following information is provided: 1. Routes for driving, public transport and walking 2. Walking <u>routes</u> ✓ and <u>time</u> ✓ needed 3. Details and street view
