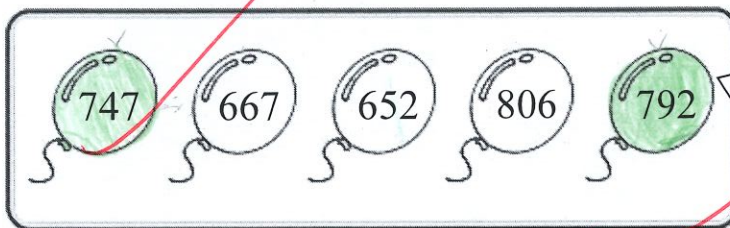


8. In the number 654,
