B. Preview method: Think and record.



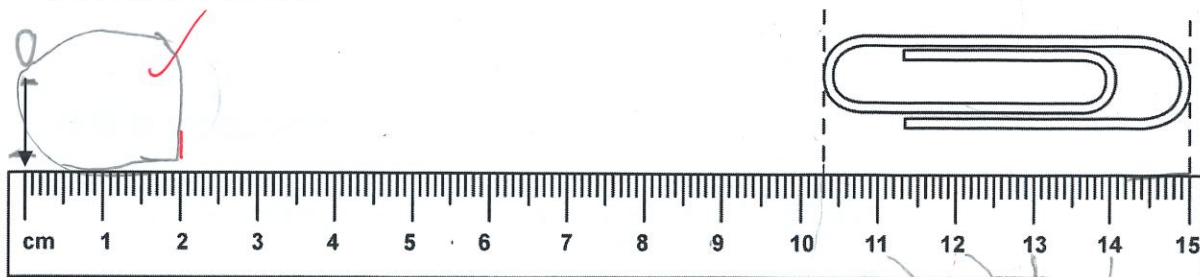
Estimate and then measure the thickness of the textbooks in millimeters.

	Maths textbook	<u>GS</u> ✓ textbook
Estimate	about <u>10</u> ✓ mm	about <u>3</u> ✓ mm
Measurement	about <u>6</u> ✓ mm	about <u>3</u> ✓ mm

I find that Maths ✓ textbook is thicker.

2. Draw an eraser that one end of the eraser is at the '0' mark on the ruler.
